Controlled Drugs Part 2 and 3	Part 2: phenobarbital, butorphanol, nalbuphine Part 3: Androderm, depo-testosterone, Andriol					NO
Controlled Drug Preps Part 2 (controlled + 1 or more)	Fiorinal					NO
Benzodiazepines & other targeted	alprazolam, bromazepam, chlordiazepoxide, clobazam, diazepam, ethchlorvynol, lorazepam, oxazepam, temazepam, triazolam, meprobamate					ONCE
Prescription Drugs						YES

- written prescription
- verbal prescription
- records kept for >=2 years
- sales reports required (except for dextropropoxyphene, propoxyphene)
- report loss/theft <10 days
